

## "HARNESSTOM: 2<sup>nd</sup> Review Meeting Steady and huge progress made by HARNESSTOM on the use GenRes materias /info to produce high quality fruit in the face of emerging diseases and climate change."

The second review meeting of the HARNESSTOM project took place online on Dec 15th, 2023, where partner present the progress made during the last 18 months of the project (April 2021 till Sep 2023). Reviewers believe HARNESSTOM is making an excellent progress in 1) developing the ONE-STOP-SHOP for tomato information for scientist and breeders; 2) developing prebreeding materials for resistance to rugose virus (TOBRFV), new delhi virus (ToLCNDV) and Cladosporium fulvum; 3) developing prebreeding materials for increase content in volatiles associated to good flavor; 4) prebreeding materials produced in interaction between scientist and farmers and information from citizen scientist. The HARNESSTOM database id constructed and operational now being populated with more data from different EU-funded projects. All prebreeding programs including those in collaboration are well advanced and the materials will be assessed this coming year. Genotyping and phenotyping of additional collections and improved technologies for speed breeding were also successful and workable protocols transferred to participating companies. Reviewers acknowledged the progress made and produced interesting feedback and suggestions.
