



" HARNESSTOM join forces with other EU-Funded projects at the EUCARPIA Tomato meeting held in Valencia"

The Coordinators of eight EU-funded project on tomato: TRADITOM, HARNESSTOM, G2PSOL, BRESOV, TOMGEM, TOMRES, SOLNUE and VIRTIGATION participated in a round table organized in the frame of the EUCARPIA tomato meeting held in Valencia on June 1st. Each EU-project coordinator presented the main aims and achievements of their respective projects that overall represent an EU funding effort of over 40 million Euros. Projects range from Traditional tomato diversity in Europe its valorization and improvement, to more general genetic resources projects on tomato and related species or more focused ones dealing with increasing resilience to specific stresses like heat stress, combined stress or emerging diseases or nitrogen o water use efficiency. As HARNESSTOM is the only Innovation action on tomato of this group of projects, it was of a special interest for HARNESSTOM to foster interactions with these projects as many of the more applied objectives of HARNESSTOM may benefit from it. A first outcome of the meeting was announced by Giovanni Giuliano coordinator of G2PSOL and leader of WP4 in HARNESSTOM dealing with tools and materials for increasing the speed and precision of breeding: a new SPET platform for tomato genotyping that includes info and developments from G2PSOL, TRADITOM and HARNESSTOM
