



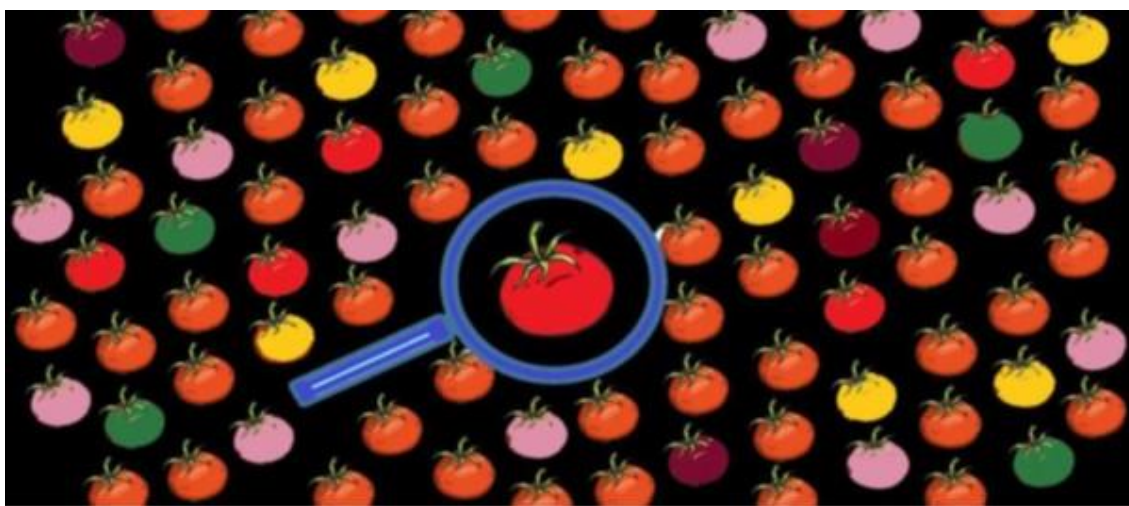
"HARNESSTOM Training School - Find my ideal Tomato"
