

## HARNESSTOM participates in Horticulture Library Talks.

On April 27th HARNESSTOM coordinator Toni Granell participated in a session of talks at the Library on "[The technological revolution of genomic editing of plants](#)". The talk was also attended by Marcos Egear Cortinez (UPCT) and Yolanda Sainz (Abiopep). Talks in the Library is a space to discuss topics of interest on production and postharvest of fruits, vegetables and ornamentals, and healthy eating. The topic of plant gene editing is hugely topical and this technology will be used within HARNESSTOM WP4 to try to assess whether it can be used to accelerate the accuracy and speed of breeding. The discussion included a review of the status of genomic editing of crops in Europe and the importance of revising its legislation so that it does not hinder competitiveness and innovation.
